

The United Nations Geneva launches the implementation of the Portail des Nations

The United Nations Geneva has recently secured approval to construct its new Visitors Center. Construction is now underway, with a scheduled opening to the public in summer 2025.

According to the framework agreement signed with the Fondation Portail des Nations in 2019, the United Nations Geneva will be equipped with a new infrastructure entirely dedicated to enhancing the reception, information dissemination, and security for visitors to the Palais des Nations. Designed by a renowned Geneva-based architectural firm, this new complex aims to be both understated and efficient. It will serve as a model for integrating sustainable development goals in construction practices.

The future Visitors Center of the United Nations Geneva, spanning approximately 2,000 square meters, will be located below the Flag Alley, with its entrance facing the *Place des Nations*. With a capacity to host 250,000 visitors annually, it will offer a multimedia and interactive experience, showcasing the UN's multilateral role and the work of its entities in Geneva.

Named the *Portail des Nations*, this project, spearheaded by Geneva's Ivan Pictet, has achieved a significant milestone: the construction of pavilion buildings on behalf of the United Nations Geneva, which will house the visitor experience. This endeavor is closely coordinated with UN entities based in Geneva. The construction phase is slated for 18 months, with plans for a public opening in summer 2025.

For the UN, the donation from the Fondation Portail des Nations represents a tangible response to the United Nations Secretary-General, António Guterres's call for greater awareness of the UN's role and operations. Through the visitor experience, visitors will gain a better understanding of the multilateral system in which the UN Geneva operates, from its everyday impact to its activities on the ground. The goal is to foster increased public engagement with discussions held within UN entities and to provide insights into addressing the world's most pressing challenges.
